first place large nonprofit publishers illustrated covers 2010 washington book publishersnamed one of the top five books of 2009 by anne grant the providence journal this history of father daughter incest in the united states explains how cultural mores and political needs distorted attitudes toward and medical knowledge of patriarchal sexual abuse at a time when the nation was committed to the familial power of white fathers and the idealized white family for much of the nineteenth century father daughter incest was understood to take place among all classes and legal and extralegal attempts to deal with it tended to be swift and severe but public understanding changed markedly during the progressive era when accusations of incest began to be directed exclusively toward immigrants blacks and the lower socioeconomic classes focusing on early twentieth century reform movements and that era s epidemic of child gonorrhea lynn sacco argues that middle and upper class white males too molested female children in their households even as official records of their acts declined dramatically sacco draws on a wealth of sources including professional journals medical and court records and private and public accounts to explain how racial politics and professional self interest among doctors social workers and professionals in allied fields drove claims and evidence of incest among middle and upper class white families into the shadows the new feminism of the 1970s she finds brought allegations of father daughter incest back into the light creating new societal tensions against several different historical backdrops public accusations of incest against genteel men in the nineteenth century the epidemic of gonorrhea among young girls in the early twentieth century and adult women s incest narratives in the mid to late twentieth century sacco demonstrates that attitude shifts about patriarchal sexual abuse were influenced by a variety of individuals and groups seeking to protect their own interests

in this new interpretation of the making of modern america dawley traces the group struggles involved in the nation s rise to power probing the dynamics of social change he explores tensions between industrial workers and corporate capitalists victorian moralists and new women native protestants and catholic immigrants

arc of containment recasts the history of american empire in southeast and east asia from world war ii through the end of american intervention in vietnam setting aside the classic story of anxiety about falling dominoes wen qing ngoei articulates a new regional history premised on strong security and sure containment guaranteed by anglo american cooperation ngoei argues that anticommunist nationalism in southeast asia intersected with preexisting local antipathy toward china and the chinese diaspora to usher the region from european dominated colonialism to us hegemony central to this revisionary strategic assessment is the place of british power and the effects of direct neocolonial military might and less overt cultural influences based on decades of colonial rule as well as the considerable influence of southeast asian actors upon anglo american imperial strategy throughout the post war period arc of containment demonstrates that american failure in vietnam had less long term consequences than widely believed because british pro west nationalism had been firmly entrenched twenty plus years earlier in effect ngoei argues the cold war in southeast asia was but one violent chapter in the continuous history of western imperialism in the region in the twentieth century

madness is of course personally experienced but because of its intimate relationship to the sociocultural context it is also socially constructed culturally represented and socially controlled all of which make it a topic rife for sociological analysis using a range

of historical and contemporary textual material this work exercises the sociological imagination to explore some of the most perplexing questions in the history of madness including why some behaviors thoughts and emotions are labeled mad while others are not why they are labeled mad in one historical period and not another why the label of mad is applied to some types of people and not others by whom the label is applied and with what consequences

An 80% confidence interval, in particular, suggests that if we were to repeatedly sample and construct intervals using the same method, 80% of these intervals would contain the true population parameter. This article will explore how z-scores play a crucial role in calculating these intervals.

## 1. What is a Z-score?

A z-score, also known as a standard score, measures how many standard deviations a particular data point is away from the mean of its distribution. A positive z-score indicates the data point is above the mean, while a negative z-score indicates it is below the mean. The formula for calculating a z-score is:  $Z = (X - \mu) / \sigma$  Where: X is the individual data point  $\mu$  (mu) is the population mean  $\sigma$  (sigma) is the population standard deviation For example, if the average height ( $\mu$ ) of women in a city is 5'4" (64 inches) with a standard deviation ( $\sigma$ ) of 3 inches, and a woman is 5'7" (67 inches) tall, her z-score would be: Z = (67 - 64) / 3 = 1 This means she is one standard deviation taller than the average woman in the city.

# 2. The Role of Z-scores in Confidence Intervals

Confidence intervals use z-scores to define the boundaries of the interval. The specific z-score used depends on the desired confidence level. For an 80% confidence interval, we need to find the z-scores that enclose the central 80% of the standard normal distribution. This means 10% of the area lies in each tail (100% - 80% = 20%, divided by 2 tails = 10%). Using a z-table or

statistical software, we find that the z-score corresponding to the 90th percentile (leaving 10% in the right tail) is approximately 1.28. Therefore, the z-score for the 10th percentile (leaving 10% in the left tail) is -1.28. These z-scores,  $\pm 1.28$ , form the basis for calculating our 80% confidence interval.

# 3. Calculating an 80% Confidence Interval for the Population Mean

The formula for calculating an 80% confidence interval for the population mean ( $\mu$ ) is: Confidence Interval =  $\bar{x} \pm (Z (\sigma / \sqrt{n}))$  Where:  $\bar{x}$  (x-bar) is the sample mean Z is the z-score (1.28 for an 80% confidence interval)  $\sigma$  is the population standard deviation n is the sample size Example: Let's say we have a sample of 25 students, and their average test score ( $\bar{x}$ ) is 75 with a population standard deviation ( $\sigma$ ) of 10. The 80% confidence interval would be: Confidence Interval = 75 ± (1.28 (10 /  $\sqrt{2}$ 5)) = 75 ± 2.56 Therefore, the 80% confidence interval for the population mean test score is (72.44, 77.56). We can be 80% confident that the true average test score for the entire student population falls within this range.

# 4. Using the Sample Standard Deviation (when population SD is unknown)

Often, the population standard deviation ( $\sigma$ ) is unknown. In such cases, we use the sample standard deviation ( $\sigma$ ) as an estimate. However, this requires using the t-distribution instead of the z-distribution, especially for smaller sample sizes. The t-distribution accounts for the added uncertainty introduced by estimating the standard deviation from the sample. The process is similar but uses the t-score instead of the z-score.
